Part A: Plan of Action

Action taken Report on IQAC 2009-10:

Infrastructural modifications and related works were satisfactorily done. Process for construction of Girls’ hostel was initiated. Research was geared as much as possible. 1-year degree course in Library and Information Science, Post-Graduate Course in Business Administration were started.
