Part A: Plan of Action

Part B: Details of activities

UGC Cell activity:

- UGC Cell organized five out of six proposed courses. 84 students were coached for Entry into services classes, 102 students were coached in Remedial classes, 54 students were coached in NET/SET classes and 56 students were coached in classes meant for Short term programmes for equal opportunities.

UGC CPE Status:

- CPE status from the UGC could not be obtained due to excess load of Intermediate classes that cannot be left out without a policy decision from the State Government..

Action Take Report on IQAC's previous year resolutions:

Laboratory facilities were augmented in Science departments e.g. Physics and Chemistry. Students were made better representation in meetings of the administrative bodies by inviting their representatives. NCC and NSS units were revamped with the help of their coordinators / officers Dr. Ajay K. Singh and Dr. Poonam. They enlarged their student base and their activities and enhanced their activities about 2-fold. UGC Cell was made fully functional. Plantation drive was undertaken twice during the year. New companies like Alchem laboratories were approached for on-job training of students and absorption in future. UGC Cell provided free coaching to students of backward classes and SC/Minority.
